

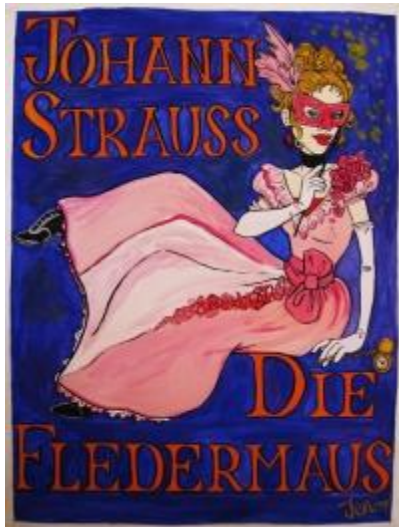

In a possible operatic first, husband-and-wife Eisenstein and Rosalinda are sung by husband-and-wife Daniel Ebbers and Jessica Siena, and husband-and-wife Sascha Joggerst and Jillian Boye sing Frank and Adele (no, those are not married in the opera; enough is enough).

Singing without significant others on stage (as far as it's known) are David Gustafson as Alfred, Igor Vieira as Falke, and Cybele Gouverneur as Prince Orlovsky.
